**OTHER NEWS**

The annual visit of the LEJOG Reliability Trial on 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> December proved especially tough this year, with heavy snow the majority of the way through from Carlisle to John O'Groats adding to the event's already formidable reputation. The BMW 2002Tii of Andy Lane & Iain Tullie finished 1<sup>st</sup> overall, but missed out on an illustrious Gold Medal, with only 3 of the 71 entered crews achieving the feat.

Paisley once again played host for the second year running to one of the start points for the Monte Carlo Historic Rally, with an estimated crowd of 10,000 seeing the cars off on the evening of Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> January, generating an estimated £1million boost to the Renfrewshire economy. Five Scottish crews made it to the finish ramp in Monaco, with the Opel Kadett of Gordon & David Glen the best of those in 176<sup>th</sup> overall.

Ian Crosbie of SoSCC is leading a new Borders Targa Rally Challenge, featuring the Grierson & Graham Rally, plus new events to be hosted by BECC on 5<sup>th</sup> July, & Spadeadam MC on 16<sup>th</sup> August.
